## Feltzen South Walk

## Getting there

The road to Feltzen South is off route 332, the Lunenburg-Riverport highway. Follow the signs for The Ovens. On leaving the highway, drive 2.3km to reach The Ovens turn-off, and park close to this intersection.

## Long Walk

Start down the hill towards the water of Lunenburg Bay. Soon you will be close to the shore and the dark sand beach of Spindler Cove. Around a turn is the Wesley United Church (1km) and the Feltzen South wharf.

At 1.9km you reach the Lutheran church. The pavement ends at 2.6km, then you pass the small community cemetery located right on the shore. Now the road rises and turns to cross over Moshers Head and back down to reveal Moshers Cove. At this point the road is so low that if it happens to be high tide, you seem to be practically walking on the water.

Continue on to the very end of the road (4.4km) to

get a view of Corkums Island, and the waters of Lower South Cove.

Return by the same route to the end of Moshers Cove, then make the sharp right turn onto South Cove Drive. This is a narrow, but good new gravel road which goes steeply uphill through the woods. It comes out to a cleared area at the top of the hill, and has a spectacular view (6.1km). Bayport lies to the S.W. Across lower South Cove. To the N.W. is Corkums Island. Part of the town of Lunenburg, and the fish plant at Battery Point, can be seen to the North.

Return directly to the point of beginning. The total distance is about 10.5km.

## Short Walk

Continue to drive on further and park close to the wharf. Walk through Feltzen South as described above only until you reach Moshers Cove. Now turn left onto South Cove Drive and continue up to the top. Return by the same route.

Total distance is about 6.8km
